RESOLUTION **OF** THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT. OCEAN, COUNTY OF STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE ADMIRAL COURT, ENSIGN AVENUE, HELM STREET AND MIZZEN DRIVE REPAVING PROJECT TO JOHNSON BARAN CORP.

WHEREAS, the Township has received letters from the Township Engineer and the Township Solicitor recommending that the bid from the apparent lowest bidder, Jersey II, Inc., be rejected for the reasons set forth in those letters of recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the bid documentation submitted by the lowest responsible bidder, Johnson Baran Corp., has been reviewed by the

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Township's professional staff and found to be acceptable and in full compliance with the bid specifications; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the bid submitted by the lowest responsible bidder, Johnson Baran Corp., is in accordance with the Township's budgetary constraints:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this 3rd day of May, 2010, by the Township Committee of the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The Township accepts the recommendations of its professional staff and awards the bid for the project to the lowest responsible bidder, Johnson Baran Corp., for and in consideration of \$166,719.43.
- 2. This contract is contingent upon review and approval of NJDOT.
