ORDINANCE NUMBER 2011-15

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY CANCELLING CERTAIN FUNDED APPROPRIATION BALANCES HERETOFORE PROVIDED FOR VARIOUS GENERAL CAPITAL PROJECTS TOTALING \$120,000.00 AND REAPPROPRIATING SUCH FUNDED APPROPRIATION BALANCES FOR VARIOUS GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVMENTS AND TO REAPPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$120,000.00 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of Barnegat, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) pursuant to the Local Bond Law, Chapter 169 of the Laws of the State of New Jersey, as amended and supplemented ("Local Bond Law"), as follows:

SECTION 1. The following funded appropriations remaining as a balance in the bond ordinance heretofore adopted by the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean, New Jersey ("Township") are hereby cancelled:

Ordinance #04-47 \$120,000.00

SECTION 2. The aggregate sum of \$120,000.00 is hereby reappropriated from the bond ordinance referred to in Section 1. The elements of the ordinance are described below:

Town Hall Improvements

This will finance improvement work ongoing at Town Hall. Included will be both interior and exterior work consisting of landscaping, irrigation installation, lighting, paving, drainage, trash and recycling containers, wall and ceiling work, and information and directional signs.

Amount of Appropriation -- \$30,000.00

Equipment Acquisition

For the purchase of four (4) used recycling trucks from the Township of Stafford along with the purchase of one (1) used bucket truck with a 30 foot boom. Also will include the purchase of lighting and communication equipment needed to properly place the trucks into service.

Amount of Appropriation--\$30, 000.00

Sidewalk Installation

Continue work associated with the safe routes to school program. Work includes cost of proper sidewalk installation, signs and traffic markings, street lighting and cost required legal and engineering services necessary to properly acquire property and to install sidewalks.

Amount of Appropriation--\$60,000.00

SECTION 3. The period of usefulness of said purpose, within the limitation of the Local Bond Law and according to the reasonable life thereof computed from the date of said bonds authorized by this ordinance, is not less than five (5) years.

SECTION 4. The capital budget or temporary capital budget (as applicable) of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extend of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the clerk and available for inspection.

SECTION 5. The improvements authorized are not current expenses and are general improvements that the Township may lawfully make. No part of the cost of the improvements authorized hereby has been or shall be specially assessed on any property specially benefited thereby.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days following the first publication thereof after final passage, as provided by the Local Bond Law.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the foregoing ordinance was introduced on first reading at a regular meeting of the Township Committee of Barnegat Township, Ocean County, New Jersey on the 1st day of August, 2011, and will be considered for second reading and final passage after public hearing at a regular meeting of the Barnegat Township Committee to be held on the 6th day of September, 2011, at 6:30 PM, 900 West Bay Avenue, Barnegat, New Jersey, at which time and place any person desiring to be heard will be given an opportunity to be so heard.
