Good Morning --

Based on current weather forecast, it appears that Friday's snow event will be minor in nature with snowfall accumulation in the 1-3 inch range. Snow should start around sunrise Friday morning and continue for the balance of the day, with the heaviest snow occurring in the afternoon hours. Snow should end in the early evening hours (6-8pm).

Friday's snow will be primarily a salting event so it is important that all of our spreaders are operational. Plowing will be limited. Also, it is important to maintain the schools during the day since this storm will not be significant enough to close the schools. Most likely this storm will require a small crew coming in early Friday morning to prepare for the morning rush. Will work out scheduling details later in the day.

Forecast are still calling for the possibility of a larger coastal storm impacting the area on Tuesday/Wednesday of next week. Will monitor and keep all current.
