

**55-122. INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS.**

- A. *General Requirements.* All improvements, except as otherwise provided, shall be subject to inspection and approval by the Township Engineer. No underground installation shall be covered until inspected and approved by the Township Engineer or those agencies having jurisdiction over the particular installation. If such installation is covered prior to inspection, it shall be uncovered or other inspection means used, such as television or other pipeline camera as may be deemed necessary by the Township Engineer, and charges for such work will be paid for by the subdivider. The appropriate engineer shall be notified by the developer

at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the start of construction.

- B. *Inspection Not Acceptance.* Inspection of any work by the Township Engineer or his authorized representative shall not be considered to be final approval or rejection of the work but shall only be considered to be a determination of whether or not the specific work involved was being done to Township specifications or other required standards at the time of inspection. Any damages to such work or other unforeseen circumstances such as the effect of the weather, other construction, changing conditions, settlement, etc., between the time of installation and the time that the developer wishes to be released from his performance guaranty shall be considered accepted until the release of the performance guaranty.
- C. *Payment to Contractors.* No developer shall enter into any contract requiring the Township Committee, the Township Engineer or any of their agents, employees or other representatives to make any declarations, written or otherwise, as a condition of payment of said developer to a contractor as to the acceptance or rejection of the work. Neither the Township Committee, the Township Engineer nor any or their agents, employees or representatives shall make any such declaration.
