

55-163. CEMETERIES.

Cemeteries may be permitted, subject to the issuance of a conditional use permit, in the districts designated, provided that compliance with the following minimum standards are achieved:

- A. A cemetery shall be permitted to include as accessory uses such uses as are on the same lot and customarily incidental to the operation of a cemetery, such as a chapel, living quarters for a caretaker and storage facilities for maintenance equipment.
- B. A maximum of two (2) identification signs may be permitted along any one (1) public road. The total sign area shall not exceed in square feet ten percent (10%) of the frontage along such public road, measured in feet, or one hundred (100) square feet, whichever is smaller.
- C. Minimum setbacks:
 - (1) Graves shall be set back from the center line of any public right-of-way a minimum of one hundred (100) feet. Graves shall be set back a minimum of fifty (50) feet from any other property line.
 - (2) Accessory buildings shall be set back a minimum of two hundred (200) feet from the center line of any public right-of-way. Accessory buildings shall be set back a minimum of two hundred (200) feet from any property line.
