

55-188.4. Lagoon and Waterfront Properties. [Added 9-11-95 by Ord. No. 1995-41 and Ord. No. 1995-42 § 3]

- A. It is the purpose of this section to ensure that property owners in the area lagoon and waterfront properties should have an unrestricted view of the water or waterways adjoining their properties.
- B. Any owner of property located on a body of water or a lagoon shall be restricted to see through fencing of their respective properties and said fencing shall not be greater than forty-eight (48) inches in height from the grade of the land upon which it is erected.
- C. See through fencing is hereby defined as any fence or fencing having a consistent density of not greater than fifty percent (50%) for all fences, living fences and hedges.
