RECYCLING INFORMATION / GUIDELINES-(Recycling and Trash Cans can be NO larger than 32 Gallons)

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING:

Residential recycling means all bottles, cans, plastic, paper, cardboard, newspapers, junk-mail, magazines, and shredded paper can now be placed in ONE container. Please **DO NOT** twine any items. ITEMS that are **NOT** recycling are carbon paper, cereal and food boxes, gift boxes, wrapping paper, plastic bags, plastic & foil wrap, paper towels, soiled or painted paper. *Recycling bins are located behind Town Hall for resident convenience for above items ONLY.*

PHONE BOOKS- A special PHONE BOOK bin is located next to the Recycling Bins. *ONLY phone books may be placed in special bin.*

RECYCLING IS MANDATORY BY LAW YOUR TRASH WILL NOT BE COLLECTED IF IT CONTAINS RECYCLABLE ITEMS –

Since 2004 CONTAINERS CAN BE NO LARGER THAN
32 GALLONS – and WEIGH NO MORE THAN 75 LBS

BRUSH will be collected each Tuesday by appointment only. *Bundles can be no larger than 4' in length, no more than 6 bundles per collection.* Please call no later than noon Monday for Tuesday pick up, 609-698-0080 x 120.

Exceptions: Tuesday Holidays -Snowfall Emergency- Leaf Collection.

DISPOSE OF USED MOTOR OIL CORRECTLY! Barnegat residents may bring up to two (2) gallons of waste oil to the Public Works Garage Monday-Friday between 6:30am to 2:30pm. Used motor oil must be received by Public Works personnel. Used motor oil from commercial sources will not be accepted.

TECHNO TRASH

Containers in Town Hall Lobby for collection of hand-held electronic games, old extension cords, telephones, laptops, diskettes, CD's, Re-Chargeable and Button Cell batteries only (no household batteries).

LEAF COLLECTION 2012

PLEASE DO NOT PUT LEAVES TO CURBSIDE EARLIER THAN 7 DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR SCHEDULED WEEK, AND NO LATER THAN 6:30 AM ON MONDAY OF YOUR SCHEDULED WEEK. THE LEAVES WILL BE COLLECTED LOOSE OR IN CLEAR BAGS ONLY AS THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE INDICATES.

SPRING (1 week of collection)

Route 1 - Apr 23 - Apr 27

Route 2 – Apr 30 - May 4

Route 3 - May 7 - May 11

Route 4 - May 14 - May 18

Route 5 – May 21 – May 25

FALL (2 weeks of collection)

Oct. 29- Nov. 2; Dec 3 - Dec. 7

Nov. 5 - Nov. 9; Dec. 10 - Dec. 14

Nov.12 - Nov 16; Dec. 17 - Dec. 21

Nov 19 - Nov. 23; Dec. 24 - Dec. 28

Nov 26 –Nov. 30; Dec 31 – Jan. 4 2013
