(No more than 6 containers of each per week)

## RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING:

Residential recycling means all bottles, cans, plastic, paper, cardboard, newspapers, junk-mail, and magazines can be placed in

ONE container. Please **DO NOT** twine any items. ITEMS that are NOT recycling are solo cups, cereal and food boxes, gift boxes, wrapping paper, plastic bags, plastic & foil wrap, paper towels, soiled or painted paper.

RIGID PLASTICS- Such as Little Tykes, plastic lawn furniture and 5 gallon buckets must be taken to **Southern Ocean Recycling , 379 Haywood Rd Manahawkin Monday thru Saturday 7:30 AM – 3:00 PM.**

FLUORESCENT BULBS – Must be taken to the **Southern Ocean Recycling Center at 379 Haywood Rd, Manahawkin. Monday thru Saturday 7:30 AM – 3:00 PM**

BRUSH will be collected Tuesday's by appointment only. *Bundles can be no larger than 4' in length, no more than 6 bundles per collection.* Please call no later than noon Monday for Tuesday pick up, **609-698-0080 x 120.** *Exceptions: - Snowfall Emergency and Leaf Collection weeks. Brush can also be brought to the Recycling Center at 5 Lippencott Ave.*

DISPOSE OF USED MOTOR OIL CORRECTLY! Barnegat residents may bring up to two (2) gallons of waste oil to the Public Works Garage Monday-Friday between 6:30am to 2:30pm. Used motor oil must be received by Public Works personnel. Used motor oil from commercial sources will NOT be accepted.

## TECHNO TRASH

Containers in Town Hall Lobby for collection of hand-held electronic games, old extension cords, cell phones, laptops, diskettes, CD's, Re-Chargeable and Button Cell batteries only (*household batteries are trash*).

## LEAF COLLECTION 2019

PLEASE DO NOT PUT LEAVES TO CURBSIDE EARLIER THAN 7 DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR SCHEDULED WEEK, AND NO LATER THAN 6:30 AM ON MONDAY OF YOUR SCHEDULED WEEK. THE LEAVES WILL BE COLLECTED LOOSE OR IN CLEAR BAGS ONLY AS THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE INDICATES.
