**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT,
COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
ACCEPTING AND APPROVING EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT
WITH THE BARNEGAT TOWNSHIP SUPERIOR OFFICERS
ASSOCIATION (SOA)**

WHEREAS, the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "Township"), has negotiated a new Collective Bargaining Agreement (the "Agreement") with the Superior Officers Association (SOA); and

WHEREAS, the Township and the SOA have negotiated the terms of this Agreement for three years; and

WHEREAS, the Township believes that the acceptance and approval of the Agreement is in the long-term best interests of the Township, its taxpayers and employees; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement has been reviewed by the Township and found to be generally acceptable as to form and content:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this 21st day of February, 2012 by the Township Committee of the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Township accepts and approves the Collective Bargaining Agreement agreed upon between the Township and the Superior Officers Association for a term of 3 years, from January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2013. A true copy of the Agreement is on file at the Township Clerk's office and can be reviewed during normal business hours.

2. The Township authorizes and directs the Mayor, Township Clerk and Township Administrator to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.
