## **RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, OPPOSING THE MANDATORY FLUORIDATION IN NEW JERSEY DRINKING WATER AS REQUIRED BY A-1811 AND S-959 "NEW JERSEY PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY FLUORIDATION ACT"**

**WHEREAS,** the Township of Barnegat, Ocean of County, State of New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "Township"), is a duly constituted corporate body politic operating pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Statute 40A:31-1 *et seq.*; and

**WHEREAS,** at a recent hearing, the Assembly Health and Senior Services Committee did vote in the majority on A-1811 and the "*New Jersey Public Water Supply Fluoridation Act*" essentially proposing mandatory fluoridation in the State's drinking water supply; and

WHEREAS, at a recent hearing, the Senate Health, Human Services and Senior Citizens Committee did vote in the majority on S-959 and "*New Jersey Public Water Supply Fluoridation Act*" essentially proposing mandatory fluoridation in the State's drinking water supply; and

**WHEREAS,** although the American Water Works Association ("AWWA"), a highly regarded national organization of water professionals, has supported fluoridation, they recommend that the decision to fluoridate should be made at the local purveyor level; and

WHEREAS, alternatives exist to provide fluoride to individuals who desire it.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** this 19<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2012, by the Township Committee of the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, that the Township opposes mandatory fluoridation and requests that the decision be left to the local water purveyors; and
