ORDINANCE NUMBER 2013-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING "RECREATION PROGRAM FEES" AND TO INCLUDE TWO NEW FEES TO SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 44A OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of Barnegat, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey that the following amendments and supplements are hereby authorized as follows:

SECTION 1. The ordinance provides for deposits, payment plans, early bird and multifamily discounts on various recreation programs that include but are not limited to Preschool, Pre-K, Summer Camps (exclusive of any paid admission based trips).

SECTION 2. The above mentioned discount is for family members enrolling in the same program only. The second family member will receive 10% discount and each additional family member will receive an additional 10% discount.

SECTION 3. Discounts may not be combined. Discounts are not permitted for individual classes that include but are not limited to Mommy and Me, Children's Daily Classes, Adult Classes, After School Classes and Special Events.

SECTION 4. Two additional fees are authorized as follows:

Recreation Special Events Fees:


Non- Food Vendor	\$10.00 to \$75.00
Food Vendor	\$50.00 to \$200.00

SECTION 5. This ordinance supplements any and all recreation program fees ordinances.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall become effective upon final passage and publication according to law.
