WHEREAS, there is a need to have an Municipal Court Administrator in the office of the Municipal Court, and


WHEREAS, the Township Committee is desirous of filling the vacancy in the office aforesaid; now




As the one year appointment will expire on May 21, 2013, I would respectfully request you take steps to have a Resolution prepared and approved prior to that date.
