Be it ordained by the Township Committee of the Township of Union, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey:

§ 59-I. Code adopted by reference.

A code defining and prohibiting certain matters, things, conditions or acts and each of them as a nuisance, prohibiting certain noises or sounds, requiring the proper heating of apartments, prohibiting lease or rental of certain buildings, prohibiting spitting in or upon public buildings, conveyances or sidewalks, authorizing the inspection of premises by an enforcing official, providing for the removal or abatement of certain nuisances and recovery of expenses incurred by the Board of Health, removing or abating such nuisances and prescribing penalties for violations is hereby established pursuant to Chapter 188, Laws of 1950. A copy of said code is annexed hereto and made a part hereof without the inclusion of the text thereof herein.

§ 59-2. Title.

The said code established and adopted by this ordinance is described and commonly known as the "Public Health Nuisance Code of New Jersey (1953)."

§ 59-3. Copies on file.

Three (3) copies of the said Public Health Nuisance Code of New Jersey (1953) have been placed on file in the office of the Clerk (or other similar officer) of the Township Committee and Board of Health upon the introduction of this ordinance and will remain on file there for the use and examination of the public.

§ 59-4. Violations and penalties.

Any person who violates or neglects to comply with any provision of this ordinance or code established herein or notice issued pursuant thereto shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable to a penalty of not less than two dollars (\$2.) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.) for each violation.
