

RESOLUTION 2017 – 287

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT, COUNTY OF OCEAN STATE OF NEW JERSEY MEMORIALIZING THE RULES OF OPERATION FOR THE TOWNSHIP SKATE PARK FACILITY

WHEREAS, a proposal has been submitted in accordance with National Joint Powers Alliance National Cooperative System (N.J.P.A) from Spohn Ranch, Inc. for the delivery and installation of pre-fabricated skate park ramps and rails; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Barnegat has awarded said contract at a meeting of the Township Committee on the 4th day of April, 2017 by Resolution 2017-167; and

WHEREAS, the ramps and rails have been designed by Spohn Ranch, Inc. and fabricated in accordance with shop fabrication drawings prepared, signed and sealed by a New Jersey Professional Engineer employed by Spohn Ranch, Inc. and have informed the Township of Barnegat that the skate park is suitable for skateboard, in-line skates as well as scooter use; and

WHEREAS, the fabricator/contractor shall certify that the completed installation is in accordance with his recommended procedure; and

WHEREAS, the Ocean County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund has recommended that the rules of the skate park (as attached) be posted on site in a conspicuous manner; and

WHEREAS, it is further necessary to memorialize the approval of the design, the construction of the facility, the rules of operation, and the fact that this is not a supervised facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Governing Body of the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean State of New Jersey approve the following:

1. That the design, fabrication, and installation of ramps and rails by Spohn Ranch, Inc. are in accordance with shop fabrication drawing prepared by Spohn Ranch, Inc. are recommended and hereby approved.
2. That the rules put forth by the Barnegat Township Committee be posted at the facility that helmets must be worn by all users
3. That the fact that the skate park will be an unsupervised facility

SKATE PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Barnegat Township Skate Park shall be unsupervised, and shall be used at your own risk
- Hours of operation: 9am – Dusk, facility shall only be used during permitted hours
- During inclement weather the skate park shall be closed. There is no use when the equipment is wet or icy
- This facility is for use by skate boards, in-line skates and scooters only, no bicycles
- Use of drugs, alcohol, smoking, profanity and or vandalism is prohibited, and shall result in automatic and permanent expulsion.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for the actions of any juvenile under the age of 18.
- All users must wear helmets, use of other safety equipment is recommended (knee pads, elbow pads etc.)
- The Township is not responsible for lost or stolen property; do not bring valuable items to the skate park
- Smoking is prohibited on the grounds as per Township Ordinance 64A
- No food or drink is permitted inside the skate park with the exception of bottled water, glass is prohibited
- No amplified sounds, including boom boxes
- Spectators must remain outside the skate park fence
- Only equipment installed by the Township of Barnegat shall be used inside the skate park
- Failure to abide by skate park rules will result in temporary or permanent expulsion from the park
- Report any problems or hazardous conditions to the Barnegat Township Recreation Department or Public Works Department
