AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT TO APPROVE OF A CHANGE ORDER IN CONNECTION WITH THE 2014 BIKE PATH PROJECT PAYABLE TO KLINE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$38,232.50

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. Seq. the Township of Barnegat advertised and solicited bids for proposals for construction of a bike path known as the 2014 Bike Path Project; and,

WHEREAS, the lowest responsive bid received for the project was from Kline Construction Company in the amount of \$191,224.50; and,

WHEREAS, the Barnegat Township Engineer was informed by Kline Construction Company that an error was included in the bid specifications which has caused an increase in material and labor in the amount of \$38,232.50; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Barnegat's Engineer has confirmed that the bid specification called for 600 square feet of decorative block for a retaining wall when the actual job requires 1625 square feet; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Barnegat understands that the misinformation included in the bid specification was due to an error by the Township's consultant; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean, New Jersey that the Township authorizes an increase in the contract with Kline Construction Company in an amount of \$38,232.50; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Township officials including, but not limited to the Mayor, the Township Administrator and the Municipal Clerk, are hereby authorized and directed to take such ministerial actions as are necessary to effectuate the provisions of this resolution.
