Adopt A Street is when you go out 3x a year and clean that street. As of now they have 58 streets and 200 participants. Next clean-up is on Oct. 9th @ 10:30am at the Dunfee School. The girls thanked Mrs. Cuccinata for her help.

**Joseph Marte:** Proud US Navy Veteran! Spoke about Resolution 2021-276. He is proud of every committee member supporting this resolution raising Veteran Tax deduction from \$250 to \$500. Hoping this will pass. Thanked all members of the American Legion and VFW post 10092 for their service.

# Committee Reports: Linda Kropf, Pat Pipi, Joseph Marte, Alfonso Cirulli

**Linda Kropf:** Went over Utility report. Meter reading started September 1<sup>st</sup>. They are using new software program that was just installed. Fire hydrant and exterior building painting is ongoing. Our water compliance inspection was completed by NJDEP and we are in compliance. Water restrictions will end September 30, 2021. Spoke about 911. Gave report of first responders. Educate our children and share our stories. Remain supporting our first responders and our military.

Pat Pipi: Gave code enforcement report. 58 letters of no interest, 25 summons issued and 292 warning stickers.

**Deputy Mayor- Alfonso Cirulli:** Thanked all involved with the Adopt A Street. Town wide clean-up is on Oct. 9<sup>th</sup>. Wished everyone a Happy Rosh Hashanah. Congratulated the Fire Dept. on the new pumper truck. Thanked everybody with the set-up of 9/11. We should never forget 9/11! Working with Comcast on trying to get the district on channel 22.

The Mayor put out American Flags for the residents.

<u>Mayor's Report – Albert Bille</u>- Bids will be opening up soon for the paving of West Bay Ave. from Barnegat Blvd. to Rt. 9. We had about 30 new businesses open up in town in the past 18 months. We don't have the say in what businesses are opening up. New gazebo at Project Playground. Grandparents Day on 9/12 from 12-4 @ Project Playground. New recreation program will be coming soon. Health Fair on 9/18/21 from 10-2 at the Recreation Center.

Joseph Marte: Went over police report for August 2021. Answered 1420 calls for service, including 58 motor vehicle accidents. Over-time for august was 20% lower than August 2020. Congratulated Capt. Jason Carroll for recently graduating from Institute for Police. Officers of the month, Det. Bill Hetrick and Ptl. Rob Armstrong. Memorial service for 9/11 @ BHS. At 8:00 AM.

**Diane Grockenberg – 108 Redwood Dr.** – Thanked Chief Germain and his police department for what they done in Pinewood Estates. Still having issues. They do not put notices out for water. They have a new manager. Not upgrading appliances. They do so many things illegally. Roads are not fixed. Spoke to a lawyer already. Time for rent increase. Should not have to pay capital improvement for ongoing issues. Now drug problem.

Ray Lesniak – 116 Redwood Dr. – Backed up on everything that Diane has said. Need fence so people don't drive on property.

**MaryAnne Clemente – 565 E. Bay Ave.** – Upset and disappointed about Pirate's Day being moved. Created a petition to move it back to downtown of Barnegat. Impact on historical downtown businesses. Thirty years of tradition. Reason why people come here for the historical past. Not a flea market. Democratic Club President requested a booth for Pirate's Day was denied. School does not allow political activity.

Charlie Cunliffe - 135 Rockrimmon Blvd. – Jeff's camp had an event on Saturday to celebrate and thank our Veteran's. Thanked the committee for the support. Thanked Public Works for the clean up on beach. Comcast still getting Stafford not Barnegat. Mr. Dasti answered question, still researching. Asked about resolution 270, Cloverdale easement. Compass Point, low income housing. Builders clean cutting too much.

**Peg Beeker – 102 Redwood Dr.** – Upset about "Starve Poverty" didn't realize it was going to turn into a soup kitchen. Asked to change the ordinance. Also concerned about the traffic.

**Jeff Gamble – 20 Windy Reef Ct.** – Asking the committee to join the Barnegat School Board and consider passing a resolution to be sent to Gov. Murphy. A resolution to rescind mask mandate for NJ children when in school. Mask can be harmful to our children. A study was done in Sweden that followed 2,000,000 children. No mask mandate, no death due to Covid. Hospital rate was less than 1 per 1,000. Please help keep our American way of life.
