ORDINANCE NO. 2022-1

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT,
COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 71
OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED “VEHICLES
AND TRAFFIC” AND SPECIFICALLY
SUBSECTION 15 THEREOF ENTITLED
“PARKING PROHIBITED”**

WHEREAS, the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey (“the Township”) has received and reviewed November 1, 2021 memorandum of the Township’s Consulting Engineer, Kurt Otto, PE of CME Associates regarding a street traffic investigation which was completed in conjunction with the Township’s Police Department;

WHEREAS, as a result of the investigation it is recommended that there be an implementation of street parking restrictions along certain Township streets;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the Township Committee of the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 71-15 of the Township Code entitled “Parking prohibited” is hereby amended to include the following restrictions:

Q. There shall be no parking on either side of Pennsylvania Avenue between Barnegat Boulevard and Ravenwood Boulevard.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

As per your request, our office has investigated both the current condition and layout of Pennsylvania Avenue, as well as reviewed its current demand and potential for "No Parking" designation, from Barnegat Boulevard to Ravenwood Boulevard.

Our office performed the following tasks: Site investigation as to current condition of Pennsylvania Avenue, reviewed potential Average Daily Traffic (ADT) based upon existing development within the area, consulted with Township Police, Fire and EMS officials, and reviewed acceptable State of NJ documentation regarding residential street hierarchy and cartway designs.

Current Condition

Presently, Pennsylvania Avenue is a 30 foot paved cartway, with curbing on both sides and sidewalk to the north. A recent 8 lot subdivision along the southerly portion of Pennsylvania Avenue, between Barnegat Boulevard and Ravenwood Boulevard, will include new sidewalks connecting Barnegat Boulevard to existing well house driveway, approximately 900 feet in length. These eight lots would all have driveways that access Pennsylvania Avenue. Pennsylvania Avenue is currently not striped, and in poor to good condition. Base repair is needed, as well as top course restoration throughout the investigated portion.

Presently, only one house (#174) and Township Well house driveway, are the only access driveways to the southern portion of Pennsylvania Avenue, from Barnegat Boulevard to Ravenwood. No driveways exist to the north. The recent subdivision approved 8 new driveways along the southerly portion of Pennsylvania Avenue. As a result, recently, township residents have expressed safety concerns regarding the newly approved houses, potential for parking on Pennsylvania Avenue, and the present volume of traffic Pennsylvania Avenue.

Current Demand

In order to review the anticipated current demand (ADT) upon this portion of Pennsylvania Avenue, our office totaled the number of existing homes that would connect to Pennsylvania Avenue via the northerly Ravenwood Boulevard extension, see attached map. This totaled 251 single family units. Utilizing Table 4.1 of RSIS, a peak rate of 10.1 trips per day for a single family dwelling would total 2535 ADT. As per Table 4.2 of RSIS, this would equate to a street hierarchy of a Minor Collector, which operates between 1500 and 3500 ADT. Both tables are attached.

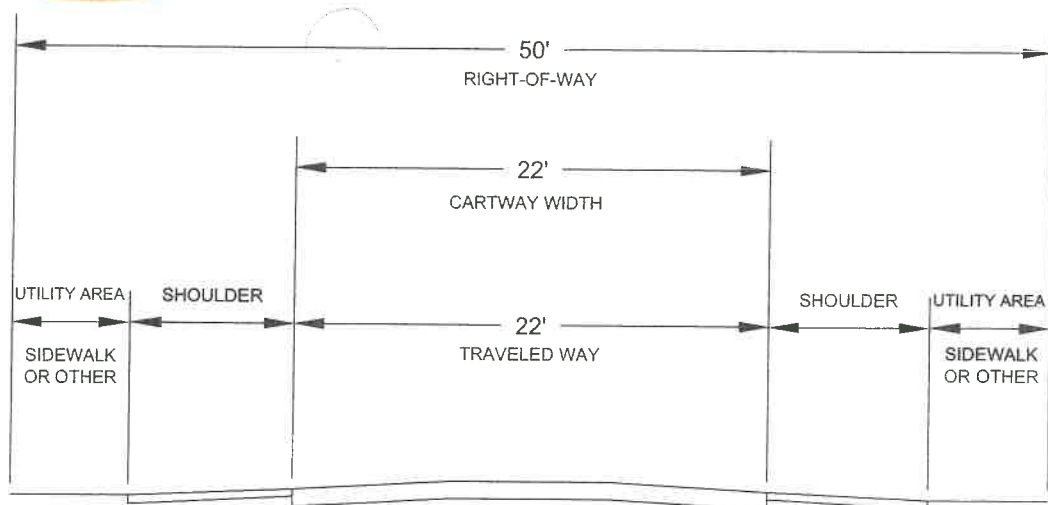

ORDINANCE NO.-2022-2

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT,
COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 3
OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED "ENGINEER,
MUNICIPAL"**

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey that Chapter 3 of the Township Code entitled "Engineer, Municipal" it is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 3 of the Township Code entitled "Engineer, Municipal" is hereby amended to read as follows:

§3-1 Creation of Position.

It is hereby established that within the Township of Barnegat the position of Municipal Engineer. The Municipal Engineer shall be appointed annually by the Township Committee and may be a full-time Township employee or otherwise a professional appointment and subject to such retainer, salary, and/or fees as approved by the Township Committee.

§3-2 Qualifications.

The qualifications for the position of Municipal Engineer shall be as follows:

- A. Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelors' degree.
- B. Duly licensed as a professional engineer in the State of New Jersey for at least five (5) years.
- C. At least five (5) years' experience in State, County, Regional or Municipal engineering Activities.

§3-3 Powers and Duties.

The Municipal Engineer shall perform such duties as our prescribed by general law and ordinance and, in addition, shall:

- A. Prepare, or cause to be prepared, all plans, designs and specifications for public works and improvements undertaken by the Township;
- B. Provide and maintain surveys, maps, plans, specifications and control records with respect to public works owned and operated by the Township;
- C. Provide technical and engineering advice and assistance to other Township departments;
- D. Recommend to the Township Committee the undertaking of needed capital projects within the Township;
- E. Assist in the formation and implementation of the Township capital budget;
- F. Supervise and direct all inspection services and inspection personnel of the Township excluding those services, inspection and personnel under the authority of the Township Code Official;
- G. Assign, supervise, and direct with the approval of the Township Committee or business administrator, projects to those special consulting engineers authorized by the governing body and supervised the same;
- H. Supervise all personnel under their supervision; and
- I. Upon termination, all papers, documents, memoranda, report and other materials relating to the administration engineering duties of the engineer shall be and remain the property of the Township;
- J. Oversee and supervise the Township water and sewer utility and all engineer services necessary for the water and sewer utility; and
- K. Shall have all other powers, duties, and responsibilities as set forth in the Barnegat Township Code.

§3-4 Special Engineering Consultants.

The Township Engineer is authorized, within the available appropriations, to employ such additional engineering staff to aid in such engineering projects, actions, causes or proceedings of importance, as he or she may deem necessary. If, at any given time, the Township Engineer cannot handle a project for the Township, the Township Committee may retain such separate engineering or planning consultants to handle such specific project for the Township, upon the authorization of the Township, from a list of engineers approved by resolution of the Township Committee.

CASH MANAGEMENT PLAN OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY

1. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

This Cash Management Plan (the "Plan") is prepared pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A.40A:5-14 in order to set forth the basis for the deposits ("Deposits") and investment ("Permitted Investments") of certain public funds of the Township of Barnegat, pending the use of such funds for the intended purposes. The Plan is intended to assure that all public funds identified herein are deposited in interest bearing Deposits, if permitted, or otherwise invested in Permitted Investments hereinafter referred to. The intent of the Plan is to provide that the decisions made with regard to the Deposits and the Permitted Investments will be done to insure the safety and preservation of the principal value, the liquidity (regarding its availability for the intended purposes) and the maximum investment return within such limits. The Plan is intended to insure that any Deposit or Permitted Investment matures within the time period that approximates the prospective need for the funds deposited or invested so that there is not a risk to the market value of such Deposits or Permitted Investments.

2. IDENTIFICATION OF FUNDS AND ACCOUNTS TO BE COVERED BY THE PLAN

- A. The Plan is intended to cover the deposit and/or investment of the following funds and accounts of the Township of Barnegat:

Current Fund
General Capital Fund
Water/Sewer Utility Operating Funds
Water/Sewer Utility Capital Fund
Trust Funds
Payroll Funds
Grant Funds

3. DESIGNATION OF OFFICIALS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT AUTHORIZED TO MAKE DEPOSITS AND/OR INVESTMENTS UNDER THE PLAN:

Tax Collector

4. DESIGNATION OF DEPOSITORIES

The following banks and financial institutions are hereby designated as official depositories for the Deposit of all public funds referred to in the Plan, including any Certificates of Deposit which are not otherwise invested in Permitted Investments as provided for in the Plan:

5. AUTHORIZED INVESTMENTS

- A. Except as otherwise specifically provided for herein, the Designated Officials are hereby authorized to invest public funds covered by this Plan, to the extent not otherwise held in Deposits, in the following Permitted Investments:
- (1) Bonds or other obligations of the United States of America or obligations guaranteed by the United States of America;
 - (2) Government money market mutual funds
 - (3) Any obligation that a federal agency or a federal instrumentality has issued in accordance with an act of Congress, which security has a maturity date not greater than 397 days from the date of Purchase, provided that such obligation bears a fixed rate of interest not dependent on any index or other external factor;
 - (4) Bonds or other obligations of the Local Unit or bonds or other obligations of school districts of which the Local Unit is a part or within which the school district is located;
 - (5) Bonds or other obligations, having a maturity date not more than 397 days from the date of purchase, approved by the Division of Investment of the Department of the Treasury for investment by Local Units;
 - (6) Local Government Investment Pools;
 - (7) Deposits with the State of New Jersey Cash Management Fund established pursuant to section 1 of P.L. 1977, c.281 (C.52:18A-90,4) or
 - (8) Agreements for the repurchase of fully collateralized securities if:
 - (a) the underlying securities are permitted investments pursuant to paragraphs (1) and (3) of this subsection a;
 - (b) the custody of collateral is transferred to a third party;
 - (c) the maturity of the agreement is not more than 30 days;
 - (d) the underlying securities are purchased through a public depository defined in section 1 of P.L. 1970, c.236 (C.17:9-41); and,
 - (e) a master repurchase agreement providing for the custody and security of collateral is executed

For purposes of the above language, the terms "government money market mutual fund" and "local government investment pool" shall have the following definitions:

Government Money Market Mutual Fund. An investment company or investment trust:

- (a) which is registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission under the "Investment Company Act of 1940", 15 U.S.C. sec.90a-1 et seq., and operated in accordance with 17 C.F.R.sec. 270.2a-7.
- (b) the portfolio of which is limited to U.S. Government securities that meet the definition of any eligible security pursuant to 17 C.F.R. sec. 270.2a-7 and

repurchase agreements that are collateralized by such U.S. Government securities; and

- (c) which has:
 - (i) attained the highest ranking of the highest letter and numerical rating of a nationally recognized statistical rating organization; or
 - (ii) retained an investment advisor registered or exempt from registration with the Securities and Exchange Commission pursuant to the "investment Advisors Act of 1950" 15 U.S.C. sec. 80b-1 et seq. with experience investing in U.S. Government securities for at least the most recent past 60 months with assets under management in excess of \$500 million.

Local Government Investment Pool. An investment pool:

- (a) which is managed in accordance with 17 C.F.R. sec. 270a-7;
- (b) which is rated in the highest category by a nationally recognized statistical rating organization;
- (c) which is limited to U.S. Government securities that meet the definition of an eligible security pursuant to 17 C.F.R. sec.270.2a-7 and repurchase agreements that are collateralized by such U.S. Government securities;
- (c) which is in compliance with rules adopted pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act:, P.L. 1968, c.410 (c.52:14B-1 et seq.) by the Local Finance Board of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of community Affairs, which rules shall provide for disclosure and reporting requirements, and other provisions deemed necessary by the board to provide for the safety, liquidity and yield of investments;
- (e) which does not permit investments in instruments that: are subject to high price Volatility which changing market conditions; cannot reasonably be expected, at the time of interest rate adjustment, to have a market value that approximates par value; or utilize an index that does not support a stable net asset value; and
- (f) which purchases and redeems investments directly from the issuer, government money market mutual fund, or the State of New Jersey Cash Management fund, or through the use of a national or state bank, or through a broker-dealer which, at the time of purchase or redemption, has been registered continuously for a period of at least two years pursuant to section 9 of P.L. 1967 c.9 C.49:3-56) and has at least \$25 million in capital stock (or equivalent capitalization if not a corporation), surplus reserves for contingencies and undivided profits, or through a securities dealer who makes primary markets in U.S> Government securities and reports daily to the Federal Reserve Bank of New York its position in and borrowing on such U.S. Government securities.

- B. Notwithstanding the above authorization, the monies on hand in the following funds and accounts shall be further limited as to maturities, specific investments or otherwise as follows:

Grant Funds

5. SAFEKEEPING CUSTODY PAYMENT AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RECEIPT OF PLAN

To the extent that any Deposit or Permitted Investment involves a document or security which is not physically held by the Township of Barnegat, then such instrument or security shall be covered by a custodial agreement with an independent third party, which shall be a bank or financial institution in the State of New Jersey. Such institution shall provide for the designation of such investments in the name of Barnegat Township to assure that there is no unauthorized use of the funds or the Permitted Investments or Deposits. Purchase of any Permitted Investments that involve securities shall be executed by a "delivery versus payment" method to insure that such Permitted Investments are either received by the Township of Barnegat or by a third party custodian prior to or upon the release of the Township of Barnegat's funds.

6. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

- A. The Chief Financial Officer of the Township of Barnegat shall maintain a schedule of all deposits and investments made on a monthly basis.
- B. When an investment is purchased or sold, the Finance Officer shall report to the Governing Body the type, value, term and earned income of the investment.
- C. All other information which may be deemed reasonable from time to time by the governing body of the Township of Barnegat.

7. TERM OF PLAN

This plan shall be in effect from January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022. Attached to this Plan is a Resolution of the governing body of the Township of Barnegat approving this plan for such a period of time. This Plan may be amended from time to time.

RESOLUTION 2022 – 8

RESOLUTION 2022-64

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ALONG WITH OCEAN COUNTY OPPOSING THE TOLL INCREASES PROPOSED BY THE NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE AUTHORITY AND SOUTH JERSEY TURNPIKE AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Township of Barnegat continues to see its population grow and along with that come the need to move people to and from jobs, medical appointments, recreational activities just to name a few destinations; and

WHEREAS, our citizens heavily rely on the Garden State Parkway, the New Jersey Turnpike, and the Atlantic City Expressway to move both locally and across the state; and

WHEREAS, with almost 40 miles of the Garden State Parkway running through Ocean County, our residents again will be among the hardest hit by another toll increase of 3 percent scheduled to go into effect on January 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, more than 90,000 people living in Ocean County commute outside of the area for employment; and

WHEREAS, this toll increase comes on the heels of a 27 percent toll increase put into place September 2020 in addition to an almost 7 percent increase in U.S. consumer prices; and

WHEREAS, the Garden State Parkway serves as the main artery for our motorists who need to access jobs, be it north or south and any toll hike would have a negative effect as it increases the cost of a daily commute; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has not given the Township of Barnegat motorists any traveling options; and

WHEREAS, Route 9, the other north-south artery has not changed since it was first constructed in the 1920's, remaining on lane in each travel direction throughout the course of Barnegat while in the meantime our population has grown to almost 630,000 people in the county; and

WHEREAS, Ocean County has been continually informed by State transportation officials that dualization of Route 9 will probably never occur; and

WHEREAS, it is important to highlight that these routes are for more than just leisurely travel but are designated evacuation routes during times of emergencies; and

WHEREAS, in the last few decades, the state has made improvements to the Garden State Parkway, constructing new interchanges and upgrading existing ones but those improvements did not come to us simply because we needed them. It helped substantially to have representation on the former Highway Authority paired with Ocean County providing the initial funding to obtain the design and permitting of many of these projects; and

WHEREAS, the Jersey Shore area, based on the number of residents using the toll roads, should have representation on the New Jersey Turnpike Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Barnegat continues its urging of the state to provide improved rail service to Monmouth and Ocean counties; and

WHEREAS, Ocean County motorists, based on volume, already pour millions of dollars into the parkway through the toll system; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Barnegat and Ocean County residents will feel the financial burden of this action over and over again, not just on the road but in our stores and as consumers as prices go up even more in order to meet the demands on a shipping industry that is also paying more to bring us goods and services; and

WHEREAS, the Turnpike Authority did not provide those paying the bill with even an opportunity to comment on this increase as it is being implemented automatically; and

WHEREAS, undoubtedly, North Jersey will see the benefits to this increase as funds are provided in those northern areas for road and bridge improvements, leaving the residents of the Township of Barnegat paying the bill; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean State of New Jersey, urges Governor Murphy, New Jersey Turnpike Authority, and South Jersey Turnpike Authority to reconsider the increase in tolls on the Garden State Parkway, the New Jersey Turnpike and the Atlantic City Expressway and encourage all of our elected officials to join the efforts to oppose this toll increase.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution shall be made available to Governor Phil Murphy, all Ocean County Mayors, the 9th, 10th, 12th and 30th State Legislative Offices, the New Jersey Turnpike Authority, and the South Jersey Turnpike Authority.
