Committee Reports; Farmer, Cirulli, Marte, Bille

Al Cirulli: Gave the Fire report for the month of September. They responded to 42 calls and they have a total of 445 calls for the year. Our EMS volunteers had 30 calls for the month and Quality Medical had 272 calls.

Joseph Marte: September 2023 Police Report - Police answered 1700 call for service, 215 First Aid calls, 51 MVA, 192 Traffic enforcement details and 651 MV stops. Hoofy Fall Festival will be Saturday, October 21 from 11am – 7pm in honor of Ptl. Alex Hoffman. All proceeds will be donated to the Alex Hoffman Memorial Scholarship Fund.

Al Bille: Meadowedge social club from farm to table event tonight. September 7, 2017 the county took over Cox House. County is working on renovations. Happy Halloween!

Mayor's Report: Our tax bill for the 6th year in a row, the municipal portion only 1 cent which the average home is \$27 a year. The new Public Works and new Town Hall has no tax burden to the community. Disgusted at the school board for approving the school curriculum. We need to ban together to protect our children, especially our daughters! Spoke about an incident that happened in VA of June 2023. Men and women are equal but are not the same! Pure insanity! Commended the 4 board members who had the courage to stand up

Urge to reconsider what will be done with building.
