ORDINANCE NO. 2025-5

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT,
COUNTY OF OCEAN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
VACATING PORTIONS OF AUDUBON WAY BLOCK 210,
LOTS 20.10 AND 29**

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-1(b) and N.J.S.A. 40:67-19, the Township Committee may, by ordinance, vacate any public street or portion thereof, dedicated to public use, but not accepted by the Township, whether or not the same, or any part, has been actually opened or improved; and

WHEREAS, the Township has received an application for a partial street vacation related to a portion of Audubon Way, Block 210, Lots 20.10 and 29 on the Tax Map of the Township of Barnegat. The Township Engineer has received and reviewed a street vacation request, and the Township Engineer has issued a review memorandum dated January 22, 2025 recommending vacation; and

WHEREAS, the Metes and Bounds description for the street vacation and diagram is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Township Engineer's review memorandum, the vacation of a portion of Audubon Way is subject to the Applicant executing Deed of Access and Utility Easement Agreements and Sanitary Sewer Easement Agreements for a portion of the vacated area which is simultaneously being executed and recorded; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-1(b), the Township Committee must, by Ordinance, preserve the right of public utilities to maintain, repair and replace their existing utility facilities, including cable television facilities, in, adjacent to, over, or under the property or right-of-way to be vacated; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Barnegat, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. All public easements, right and interests to portions of right of way and/or paper street known as Audubon Way and specifically sections of Block 210, Lots 20.10 and 29 as set forth in Exhibit A will be vacated.

SECTION 2. The Township Clerk shall publish, this ordinance, after being introduced and having passed a first reading, at least once not less than ten (10) days instead of one (1) week prior to the time fixed for further consideration for final passage, shall be published at least once in a newspaper published and circulated in the Township, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:49-6.

SECTION 3. It is the intent of the Township Committee of Barnegat to vacate the aforementioned interests that the public may have in the property, and to provide that the property shall be conveyed, in its “as is” condition, to adjacent property owners for no consideration.

SECTION 4. At least seven (7) days prior to the time fixed for the consideration of this Ordinance for final passage, a copy of this Ordinance, together with a notice of its and time and place when and where the Ordinance will be further considered for final passage, shall be given by the Township Clerk to the owners of all real property, as shown on the current tax map duplicates, to be located within 200 feet in all directions of Audubon Way in the area vacated as shown in Exhibit A pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-19 and N.J.S.A. 40:49-6.

SECTION 5. The Township Clerk shall within sixty (60) days after such ordinance becomes effective file a certified copy of the ordinance vacating the street with the office of the County Clerk in a special book set aside for dedications and vacations, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-21.

SECTION 6. After introduction, this Ordinance shall be referred to the Barnegat Township Planning Board for review and comment pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-26,

N.J.S.A. 40:55D-32, and N.J.S.A. 40:55D-33, since vacation of a public street or portion thereof constitutes a change to the official map of Barnegat Township, Ocean County and the closing of a public street, albeit a paper unimproved street.


SECTION 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 8. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or any part of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance not directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 9. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.

All that certain lot, tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Township of Barnegat, the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey and being known as Audubon Way to be vacated, as shown on the plan entitled "Right-of-way Vacation & Easement Exhibit for Audubon Way, Township of Barnegat, Ocean County, New Jersey" prepared by Colliers Engineering & Design dated November 22, 2024, and being more particularly bounded and described as follows to wit:

Beginning at a point, said point being the intersection of the southeasterly right-of-way line of North Main Street (New Jersey State Highway Route 9, 66 feet wide per tax map), with the northeasterly right-of-way line of Audubon Way (50 feet wide per tax map), and running, thence

1. **S 52°11'54" E, 769.20 feet**, along the aforesaid northeasterly right-of-way line of Audubon Way, said right-of-way line also being the southwesterly boundary line of Lot 20.10, Block 210, and continuing along the southwesterly boundary line of Lot 20.09, Block 210, to the terminus of Audubon Way, thence
2. **S 37°48'06" W, 50.00 feet**, along the aforesaid terminus of Audubon Way, to a point in the southwesterly right-of-way line of Audubon Way, thence
3. **N 52°11'54" W, 765.05 feet**, along the aforesaid southwesterly right-of-way line of Audubon Way, also being the northeasterly boundary line of Lot 29, Block 210, to a point in the aforesaid southeasterly right-of-way line of North Main Street, thence

There has been a request to vacate a portion of Audubon Way by the New Jersey Institute of Disabilities. Pursuant thereto attached is a proposed ordinance for the street vacation. Contemporaneously with the vacation ordinance, there also is going to be the execution and recording of access easements where the New Jersey Institute of Disabilities will give three easements back to the Township for utility and sanitary sewer access. I am attaching herewith resolutions authorizing execution and recording of those easements as well as the easements.

You will note on the first page of each easement is the space to fill in the ordinance number. As soon as you have the ordinance number for the attached ordinance, please let me know so I can correct the first page of each easement.

The resolutions are attached authorizing the execution of the previous.

At least 7 days prior to the second reading of the ordinance, we have to publish notice to all property owners within 200 feet of the area to be vacated by certified return receipt and regular mail. So please get the addresses from the tax rolls and if you need help with the public notice on that, please let me know.

ORDINANCE 2025- 6

AN ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK IN ACCORDANCE WITH N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40a:4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and

WHEREAS, the Barnegat Township Committee of the Township of Barnegat in the County of Ocean finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2025 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous years final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Barnegat Township Committee hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$284,958 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and

WHEREAS the Barnegat Township Committee hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding year.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Barnegat in the County of Ocean, New Jersey, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2025 budget year, the final appropriations of the Township of Barnegat shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased to 3.5% amounting to \$997,353 and that the CY 2025 municipal budget for the Township of Barnegat be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon; be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Township of Barnegat that in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-7.6a & 7.6b and based upon the Chief Financial Officer's certification, the governing body has found the budget has met the following requirements:

1. That with reference to the following items, the amounts have been calculated pursuant to law and appropriated as such in the budget:
 - a. Payment of interest and debt redemption charges
 - b. Deferred charges and statutory expenditures
 - c. Cash deficit of preceding year
 - d. Reserve for uncollected taxes
 - e. Other reserves and non-disbursement items
 - f. Any inclusions of amounts required for school purposes.
2. That the provisions relating to limitation on increases of appropriations pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.2 and appropriations for exceptions to limits on appropriations found at N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.3 et seq., are fully met (complies with CAP law).
3. That the budget is in such form, arrangement, and content as required by the Local Budget Law and N.J.A.C. 5:30-4 and 5:30-5.
4. That pursuant to the Local Budget Law:
 - a. All estimates of revenue are reasonable, accurate and correctly stated,
 - b. Items of appropriation are properly set forth
 - c. In itemization, form, arrangement and content, the budget will permit the exercise of the comptroller function within the municipality.

5. The budget and associated amendments have been introduced and publicly advertised in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Local Budget Law, except that failure to meet the deadlines of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-5 shall not prevent such certification.

6. That all other applicable statutory requirements have been fulfilled.

BUILDING HEIGHT

- A. For residential properties which are not located in a flood hazard area (FHA), as defined by N.J.A.C. 7:13, building height shall be the vertical dimension measured from the average elevation of the finished grade at the front of the building to the highest point of the roof for flat roofs; the average distance between eaves and ridge level for gable, hip and gambrel roofs; and to the deck level for mansard roofs. Building height shall be a maximum of thirty-five (35) feet and 2.5 stories.
- B. For residential properties which are located in a flood hazard area (FHA), as defined by N.J.A.C. 7:13, building height shall be the vertical dimension measured from the flood hazard area design flood elevation, as defined by N.J.A.C. 7:13 and as noted in Chapter 46B-2.3 of the Township Code to the highest point of the roof for flat roofs; the average distance between eaves and ridge level for gable, hip and gambrel roofs; and to the deck level for mansard roofs. Building height in a FHA shall be a maximum of thirty-two (32) feet and 2.5 stories.
- C. For non-residential properties, building height shall be the vertical dimension measured from the average elevation of the finished grade at the front of the building to the highest point of the roof for flat roofs; the average distance

between the eaves and ridge level for gable, hip and gambrel roofs; and to the deck level for mansard roofs. Building height shall be as required by the zoning district requirements.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. 2. Every room occupied for sleeping purposes by one occupant shall contain at least seventy (70) square feet of floor space, and every room occupied for sleeping purposes by more than one occupant shall contain at least fifty (50) square feet of floor space for each occupant thereof.
3. At least one-half of the floor area of every habitable room shall have a ceiling height of at least seven (7) feet. The floor area of that part of any room where the ceiling is less than five (5) feet shall not be considered as part of the floor area in computing the total floor area in the room for the purpose of determining the maximum permissible occupancy thereof.

4. A room located in whole or in part below the level of the ground may be used for sleeping provided that the walls and floors thereof in contact with the earth have been damp-proofed in accordance with a method approved by the Administrative Authority; and provided that all requirements otherwise applicable to habitable rooms generally are satisfied.

In the case of a continuing violation or violations a fine of not less than two hundred dollars (\$200) and not more than five hundred dollars (\$500) may be assessed for each day that said violation or violations continue unabated, until such time as said violation or violations are abated. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Any person who shall violate this ordinance or any of the terms or provisions thereof or who shall do any act or thing in this ordinance prohibited or who shall neglect, refuse or fail to do any act or thing in this ordinance required to be done shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay such fine not exceeding the sum of not less than eighty dollars (\$80) or be imprisoned in the county jail for such term not exceeding fifteen (15) days as shall be determined and imposed by the Magistrate or Municipal Judge before whom such person shall be tried; provided, however, that such Magistrate shall have power in his discretion to impose both fine and imprisonment not exceeding the respective maximum limits herein fixed.

Article IV. Snow Emergencies

1. Applicant seeks Preliminary Water System Facilities approval to permit the construction of a four (4) story self-storage facility building, with a total 96,348 SF.
2. Based upon proposed number of employees, the applicant has calculated an average daily flow of 50 gpd, or .00005 MGD. Based upon proposed demand, the Township has sufficient capacity to service development, and this review acts as a "will serve" letter.
3. Applicant proposes to connect to existing water service available on West Bay Avenue, at an existing water service connection.
4. Fees: Per Chapter 74-17.2, **Preliminary Water Review Fees:**
 - a. \$500 (*received*)
5. Based upon proposed demand, and the applicant's proposal to connect to existing water service connection at West Bay Avenue, the Township has sufficient water capacity to service proposed development, and this letter acts as a "will serve" letter in terms of water service.

DESIGN COMMENTS

1. Various off-site water system improvements have been constructed by Mark Madison, LLC. In accordance with the developers' agreement between Township of Barnegat and Mark Madison, LLC, all developers within the water system service area must reimburse Mark Madison LLC for their share of the cost of the improvements constructed and paid for by Mark Madison, LLC. Therefore, as a condition of any approval granted by the Township Committee, the Applicant must pay their share of the water system costs in the amounts and at the times set forth in the developers' agreement.
2. The cover sheet shall be revised to include a signature block for the Water and Sanitary Sewer Utility Engineer for Final Approval.
3. Final water service building locations and sizing shall be dependent upon Final water system facilities submission, when final architectural plans are available to confirm location and sizing.
4. Plans do not include any proposed fire connection services. Upon pressure/flow testing, provide updated plans showing proposed fire service locations. Township Fire Official shall also review and approve of new Fire Connection locations.
5. Plans do not include a water meter pit location on utility plan, nor a meter pit detail. In addition, any details required per pending future fire department connections shall also be added to Final plan.
6. Indicate on plans nearest fire hydrant location.

OUTSIDE AGENCY APPROVALS

The application is subject to the following outside agency approvals:

1. Township of Barnegat Zoning Board.
2. Ocean County Planning Board.
3. Ocean County Soils Conservation District.
4. Ocean County Engineering Department.
5. Any other applicable outside agencies

Based on the above, we recommend the applicant be granted Preliminary Water Facilities approval subject to the Applicant meeting the above conditions.

THIS AGREEMENT made this 4th day of May 2025

BETWEEN: **THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON**, a Municipal Corporation Politic of the State of New Jersey, having its principal offices located at 95 West Veterans Highway, Jackson, NJ 08527 hereinafter referred to as

 “JacksonTownship”.

AND: **THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT**, a Municipal Corporation Politic of the State of New Jersey having its principal offices located at 900 West Bay Avenue, Barnegat, New Jersey, 08005, hereinafter referred to as **“Barnegat Township”**; and collectively Barnegat Township and Jackson Township referred to as **“the parties”**.

THIS AGREEMENT WAS AUTHORIZED BY RESOLUTION OF THE BARNEGAT TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE DATED MARCH 4, 2025; AND OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON COMMITTEE DATED _____

WHEREAS, Jackson Township and Barnegat Township wishes to enter into a Shared Services Agreement between the Township of Jackson and the Township of Barnegat dated March 3, 2025, in which Thomas Lombarski will serve as Chief Financial Officer of Barnegat Township and Jackson Township; and

WHEREAS, Jackson Township and Barnegat Township agree that it will be of mutual benefit to both municipalities to share the Chief Financial Officer services of Mr. Lombarski, for the year 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereunder **DO AGREE** as follows:

1. Thomas Lombarski is hereby appointed as Chief Financial Officer for Jackson Township with the understanding by both parties that the hours needed to fulfill the duties of CFO be approximately between 5-10 hours per week.
2. Thomas Lombarski shall perform the duties of Chief Financial Officer for Jackson Township consistent with the work responsibilities as described in the Township of Jackson Administrative Code for the position.
3. Jackson Township shall issue payment for the services of Thomas Lombarski directly to the Township of Barnegat for CFO services on a monthly basis for which payment shall be made in due course by Plumsted Township at their monthly meeting. The rate of payment shall be \$9,000 per month for services rendered, 50% to the Township of Barnegat and 50% directly to Thomas Lombarski.
4. Jackson Township shall furnish Mr. Lombarski the office supplies, equipment, IT services, and space necessary to properly perform the duties of Chief Financial Officer for Jackson Township.
5. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15 this Agreement is subject to the availability and appropriation of sufficient funds in the fiscal years in which the services are provided. The Chief Financial Officer of Jackson Township and Barnegat Township shall certify that sufficient funds are (or will be) available in the current municipal budget for this contract or by budget amendment or emergency as deemed appropriate.
6. The Term of this Agreement shall be for a period of approximately (9) months commencing March 3, 2025 through December 31, 2025. It is the intent of the parties to review and evaluate this Interlocal Shared Services Agreement for renewal at the end of the term; however, both parties agree to evaluate the arrangement and needs after 90 days from the date of this agreement. The Agreement may be terminated by either of the parties at the end of the 90 days which shall include a 30 written notice.
7. All notices required by this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be sent via regular and certified mail, return receipt requested to the Municipal Clerk of each Township at the address listed in the preamble of this Agreement.
8. This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between Jackson Township and Barnegat Township and supersedes all prior written or oral understandings. This Agreement may only be amended, supplemented, modified or cancelled by a duly executed written instrument.
9. The parties agree that this Agreement was prepared under the authority of the State of New Jersey and therefore shall be interpreted by the laws of that State.
10. Any dispute arising out of this Agreement shall be submitted for arbitration to the American Arbitration Association to be adjudicated pursuant to the rules and procedure of that organization.
