BLACK BAGS MAY ALSO BE USED FOR TRASH ONLY (NO RECYCLING AND NO WHITE BAGS)

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING:

Residential recycling means all bottles, cans, plastic, paper, cardboard, newspapers, junk-mail, and magazines can be placed in ONE container. Please **DO NOT** twine any items. **ITEMS that are NOT Recycling** are solo cups, gift boxes, wrapping paper, plastic bags, plastic wrap, paper towels, soiled or painted paper.

RIGID PLASTICS- Such as Little Tykes, plastic lawn furniture and 5 gallon buckets must be taken to **Southern Ocean Recycling, 379 Haywood Rd Manahawkin Monday thru Saturday 7:30 AM – 3:00 PM.**

FLUORESCENT BULBS – Must be taken to the **Southern Ocean Recycling Center** at 379 Haywood Rd, Manahawkin. Monday thru Saturday 7:30 AM – 3:00 PM

BRUSH will be collected by appointment only. *Bundles can be no larger than 4' in length, no more than 6 bundles per collection. 609-698-0080 x 120.*

Exceptions: -Snowfall Emergency and Leaf Collection weeks. Brush can also be brought to the Recycling Center located at 5 Lippencott Ave.

Public Works performs routine maintenance to trees along sidewalks for pedestrians and along roadways for service vehicles and normal traffic.

DISPOSE OF USED MOTOR OIL CORRECTLY! Barnegat residents may bring up to two (5) gallons per day of waste oil to the Southern Ocean Recycling, 379 Haywood Rd, Bldg. 105, Manahawkin. Used motor oil from commercial sources will **NOT** be accepted.

LEAF COLLECTION 2026

PLACE YOUR LEAVES AT THE CURB NO LATER THAN 6:30AM ON MONDAY OF YOUR SCHEDULED WEEK, THE LEAVES WILL BE COLLECTED LOOSE OR IN CLEAR BAGS ONLY (NO BLACK BAGS) AS THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE INDICATES. AS OF JANUARY 1st IT BECOMES THE RESIDENTS RESPONSIBILITY TO DISPOSE OF THEIR LEAVES.

SPRING (1 week of collection)

Route 2 - Apr. 13- Apr. 17
Route 3 - Apr. 20 - Apr. 24
Route 4 - Apr. 27 - May 1

FALL (2 weeks of collection)
